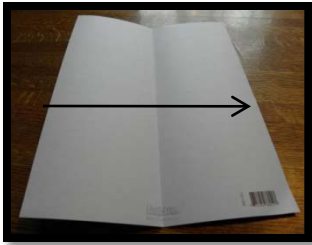


Origami Frog

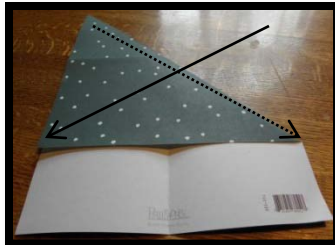
Supplies needed

Rectangular piece of paper (easiest of colored on one side)

Pen to draw eyes



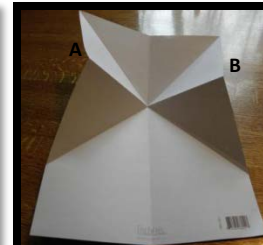
Start with a rectangular piece of paper white side up and fold in half the long way.



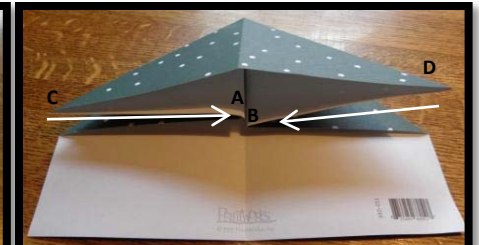
Fold each top corner to the opposite side of the paper. Then open.



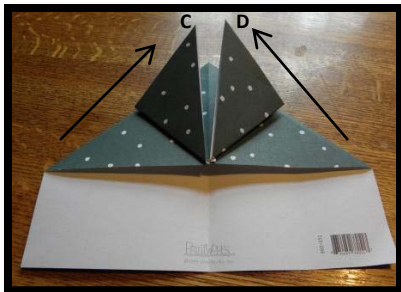
Make a diagonal fold in the paper where the center of "X" has been created by the previous fold by folding the paper backwards.



Open and the creases should appear as above.



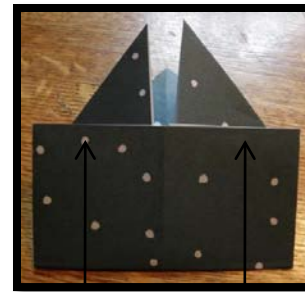
Push points (A) and (B) to the center and flatten.



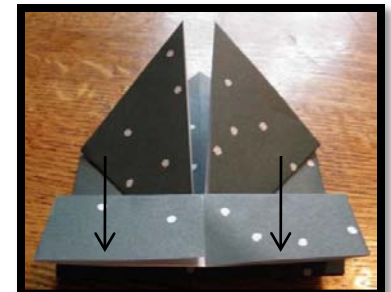
Fold the upper layer so points (C) and (D) are located at the top.



Fold both sides in toward the center. (One side shown completed in photo).



Fold the bottom up so that the end meets the top of the diamond.



Fold the same flap down. Turn over frog and draw on eyes.

Tip: Press down on frog's back near crease to make him jump. Experiment with different sizes of paper to see how far you can make your frogs jump.
